I visited various colleges in Nepal in fact through my experiences from childhood when I compared myself with my cousins and relatives who studied overseas I found them more confident and competent. They are as follows:

Australia compensates this issue by implementing TPS Act. This insures student's security. Moreover, UK is facing some serious attacks that raise security concerns for the international students.

Though the education in Canada is highly graded, studying at the university like University of Toronto, University of Waterloo etc in the cold climates would be difficult for me. tion and Care located at Sydney with the total duration of 104 weeks and the total cost is \$28,500 which is compared to SAI is more.

2) Canberra Institute of Technology: <http://www.cit.edu.au>

This institution also offers the course Certificate III and Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care. The college located in Canberra provides the total course for 104 weeks for around AUD 28,200. Even though the institute provides the course as well the reason for not choosing this provider was because of the presence of a better offer at SAI.

3) Kingston International College Pty Ltd: <http://www.kingstoncollege.wa.edu.au/>

This Institute also provides the course Certificate III and Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care. It provides the course for about 104 weeks costing about AUD 36000, which is much more when compared to SAI tuition fee of AUD22,000 for about the same period. Also, the college is located in Western Australia, which then again did not happen to be my choice.

This Institute also provides the same course for 156 weeks for the total cost \$29,000 which is one the same desire location I have chosen but some of my friends didn't recommend Lead college. That's why I didn't choose this Institute.

5) Health Careers International Pty. Ltd: www.lhna.edu.au

This Institute also offers the same course of SAI comparing the duration is same as SAI but the total cost is much higher \$36,000 to that of SAI. I find this institute is located at Melbourne, Sydney and Perth. Many of my friends are studying there they said the class room size is smaller compared to SAI. So I have chosen SAI rather than Health Careers.

I am greatly motivated and ambitious in pursuing my degree in Australia to improve my efficiency. My stay in Australia is temporary.
