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Diploma of community services

A community worker is a person who has the knowledge, skills and values to work with individuals, families, social groups or communities to promote or restore social functioning. Community worker may find work in a paid or voluntary capacity and in addition to providing direct services. Community workers can be employed in the not-profit, government and private sectors. Some community workers may want to work in organisations only, whereas others look for the relative security of government jobs that focus on the provision of human services. Community worker in non-government positions may find employment with community development organisations, welfare centres, social enterprises, neighbourhood houses, emergency relief agencies, home and community care organisations and residential care facilities.

Career plan:

After completing my diploma, I would like to continue my bachelor's degree in nursing. Thereafter, I would like to apply for the post graduate working experience and after having my experience as well as nursing degree, I would like to return back to my country as there is a very good scope of international degree along with experience. It is quite hurtful that nursing occupation is not quite respected in Nepal. The services that are available are centered in city areas, which are costly and solely dependent on medication. There are many hospitals and health care center like OM Hospital and research center, Grande hospital, Bir hospital which have been established to treat the patient of society. With my strong goal to serve the people, I will serve in OM Hospital and after that I will go to remote areas to serve old and sick person. Students like me are qualified enough to be nurse as the course that I want to pursue in college has a great value here in Nepal. I have strong bond with my country Nepal as I feel that charity begins from home, I would like to serve as much as people if I'm capable. I am aware of the hard work and perseverance necessary for the work and I know that it is not always as exciting as the published results seem to indicate. I will not be in Australia for certificate only but also for



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learning, caring, counseling and qualitative education. I will be working in remote areas of my country because to develop nation, first remote areas should be developed. Many people are illiterate there. Since, knowledge is the power to change everything, I would be providing them education there and health services there.

After completing my course, I will return and start to apply to the nursing homes that treat the elderly people and sick people. Due to lack of trained personals I am very much confident that I will have no problem in getting jobs. I will support people with patient and hard work.

Maintaining 80% of attendance

Work permit of 40hrs per fortnight

Clearance of 50% of subjects in each term

Attending the enrolled University for at least 6 months

Maintaining the Health Insurance during my entire stay

Informing the University/DIBP within 7 days if I change the address or contact details.
